

# THRIVE Kids FAQ's

## FAQ: Who can attend EUMC Thrive Kids?

All children from birth to 5<sup>th</sup> grade are welcome to join our program. However, during this time, children must not be showing any symptoms of Covid-19. We encourage students who have family members at home who might be more vulnerable to the virus, to make prayerful decisions about what is best for their personal health.

## FAQ: Is there pre-registration to attend Thrive Kids Program?

No. We expect to be able to welcome every child into our safe, learning environment. However, in order to maintain good social distancing, capacity will be limited based on room size and number of volunteers working. As such, it is possible that a class might reach capacity and be unable to accept additional children on any given program day.

## FAQ: What safety precautions are in place?

**Safe Check-in** – We have a simple check-in system located in the lobby. All you'll need to do is provide your child's name to print both child and guardian tags.

**Temperature Checks** – Our Thrive Team will check all volunteers and children upon entering the Thrive Kids area using a touchless thermometer. Persons who have a fever of 100.4F or above will not be allowed to enter.

**Masks** – Both children and volunteers are required to wear a mask while indoors. Disposable masks are available if you forget to bring one.

**Sanitization** – All frequently touched surfaces and Thrive spaces will be cleaned with a sanitizing spray after each class. Children have their own labeled supplies, such as crayons, scissors, etc, to use each week so there is no sharing of supplies.

## FAQ: What will my child learn in THRIVE Kids?

The Bible is the most amazing book ever written, and we strive to bring its stories to life through creative activities and discussions that keep kids engaged. We want every child to love God's Word and understand the value of applying it to their lives. We know they'll have fun each week as they learn about who God is through games, activities, crafts, small groups, and video teaching.

## FAQ: How do I check my child/children into Sunday programming?

On your first visit, look for the KIDS CHECK-IN station in the lobby area. If you can't find it, one of our pastors or volunteers will be happy to show you!

At the Kids Check-In, you'll be welcomed by a THRIVE volunteer eager to meet your family and show you how THRIVE works. To check your child in, we'll need some information at that time, including a family member's name, your child's name and birthday, your address, your phone number, and any special instructions, allergies, etc... We'll be there every step of the way, right up to when you drop your kids off at the appropriate room, so feel free to ask questions!

**FAQ: I have a child with special needs. Is there anything I should know before I take my kid to Thrive?**

If you have a child with special needs who might need a little extra support to participate in THRIVE kids, we'd love to partner with you to make their experience amazing when you visit!!

**FAQ: How does THRIVE Kids ensure my kid is safe and secure?**

In THRIVE kids, safety is one of our highest priorities. That's why we have a secure check-in system. Upon check-in, guardians will receive matching identification stickers. Your child will need to wear their name tag sticker and you will need to keep the matching tag. After the service, you'll show the THRIVE leaders your matching tag in order for your child to be released from their room.

Every THRIVE volunteer / team leader is screened, participates in a background check, and receives appropriate training from our staff. In the event that we need to contact you during the service, we can either send you a text message or share your child's last name and identification code on the screen in the auditorium.
