### **Psalm 30:5**

For his anger lasts only a moment, but his favor lasts a lifetime;  
weeping may stay for the night, but rejoicing comes in the morning.

### **Outline of Micah 6**

Vs. 1-5 God confronts Israel and Judah because of their sin

Vs. 6&7 Israel and Judah are going to make their defense before God

Vs. 8-12 God answers Israel (famous verse 8)

Vs. 13-16 God declares the verdict on Israel and Judah

### **James 2:17**

In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.

### **Romans 12:1-2**

Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

## **1 Samuel 15:22**

But Samuel replied: “Does the Lord delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obeying the Lord? To obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed is better than the fat of rams.
