**You cannot live in freedom if you do not understand it.**

#### **Galatians 4:1–7**

#### **John 1:12–13**

“But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God...”

#### **Romans 8:14–17**

“For all who are being led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God... and if children, heirs also, heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ.”

#### **Ephesians 1:13–14**

Believers are sealed with the Holy Spirit, who is the guarantee of our inheritance.

### **Galatians 4:21–25**

Hagar represents the covenant of the Law — slavery.  
Sarah represents the covenant of promise — freedom.

### **Galatians 4:28–29**

**Galatians 5:1** It was for freedom that Christ set us free.

**Salvation is:**

- **By grace**
- **Through faith**
- **In Christ alone**

**Cast out the bondwoman and her son.**
